

Example:

Income

- Paycheck **\$1500 x 2** – Every other week (this month pay days 3rd and 17th – highlighted in yellow)

Bills/Other Pay Outs:

- Savings **\$150 x 2** – Deposited each pay day (this month 3rd and 17th)
- Church Offering **\$150 x 2** – Due on Sunday after each pay day (this month 5th and 19th)
- House \$800 – Due 4th
- Phone \$35 – Due 6th
- Cell Phone \$45 – Due 10th
- Car Payment \$300 – Due 18th
- Water \$35 – Due 20th
- Credit Card \$110 – Due 20th (Amount spent during last month's statement period)
- Satellite \$40 – Due 24th
- Electric \$200 – Due 25th

Assuming that today is April 13th, this is what your calendar would look like as of today:
